The Research Center for Sustainability at Chiba University of Commerce is pleased to announce that it will be organizing the International Symposium on Sustainable Development and ESD (Education for Sustainable Development) on 23 September 2024 in Chiba, Japan.

Target 7 of Sustainable Development Goal 4 offers a transformative vision of education: "By 2030, ensure that all learners acquire the knowledge and skills needed to promote sustainable development, including, among others, through education for sustainable development and sustainable lifestyles, human rights, gender equality, promotion of a culture of peace and non-violence, global citizenship and appreciation of cultural diversity and of culture's contribution to sustainable development". These arguments call for education to be transformed to contribute to the sustainable development of our global village. The focus of ESD is on cognitive learning outcomes (we need the knowledge to recognize problems in our society precisely), socio-emotional ones (we need to feel responsible for these problems) and behavioral ones (we need the competencies to take action to deal with them), that help learners to be global citizens, who take action for dealing with problems of our community, the challenges addressed by the SDGs especially.

This is why we need to deepen our understanding of ESD: what is ESD, how to introduce ESD into the class, how to achieve a learner-centered pedagogy, how to cover gender equality in our daily teaching, how to stimulate learners' social emotions for our global village, etc. The proposal related to any aspects and levels of ESD is welcomed: teaching practice, curriculum, governmental education policies, etc.

We also should deepen our comprehension of sustainable development in several levels and fields because ESD can be achieved based on a precise and scientific understanding of environmental and social problems. The proposal related to any aspect of sustainable development is also welcomed: environmental, social and governance problems, climate change, epidemic, carbon tax, renewable energy, biodiversity, ESG investment, CSR, fair trade, ethical consumption, global partnership, etc.

The language of the symposium is English. Individual presentations will be 20 minutes long, followed by 10 minutes for discussion with the floor and the other presenters.
